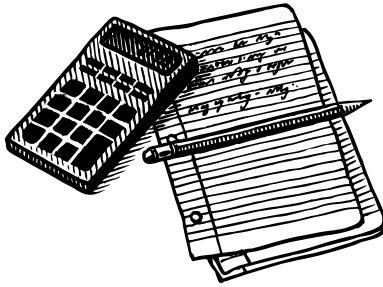
The 2012/2013 PSAT/NMSQT will be given on the Trinity Campus in the gymnasium on Wednesday, October 17, 2012. All college-bound **freshmen, sophomores and juniors** should register to take this very important preliminary test. The cost of the test is \$14.00 (fee is paid to The Collegeboard but checks should be made out to Trinity Christian Academy).

Why should college-bound **juniors** take the PSAT/NMSQT? The PSAT/NMSQT is a practice test for the Collegeboard SAT I: Reasoning Test (national recognized college admissions exam & required for the Bright Future scholarship) which every college-bound junior should take this spring (2013). (Details about this test will be given out later.) The results of the PSAT/NMSQT when taken as a junior are used to enter the competition for the National Merit Scholarship and other scholarships.

Why should college-bound **sophomores** sign up to take this PSAT/NMSQT? This is a practice for next year's PSAT/NMSQT when as a junior your score enters you in the National Merit Scholarship competition. Also sophomores accelerated in mathematics should take the Collegeboard SAT I: Reasoning Test in the spring of this year (2013).

Why should college-bound **freshmen** sign up to take this PSAT/NMSQT? Practice, practice, and more practice. You wouldn't enter an athletic competition without practice! Why enter a scholarship competition your junior year without practice? Or why take an all important college entrance exam without practice?

Please fill out the attached registration form and return this form and the fee of \$14.00 (checks should be made out to Trinity Christian Academy) to the academic office (Mrs. Denton or Mrs. Belk) by September 25, 2012. A seat in the testing will be guaranteed if received by September 25, 2012. An information sheet about the test including a practice test will be provided sometime during the last week in September to the first 150 to register. The practice test should be reviewed before taking the October 17th, PSAT/NMSQT.
